



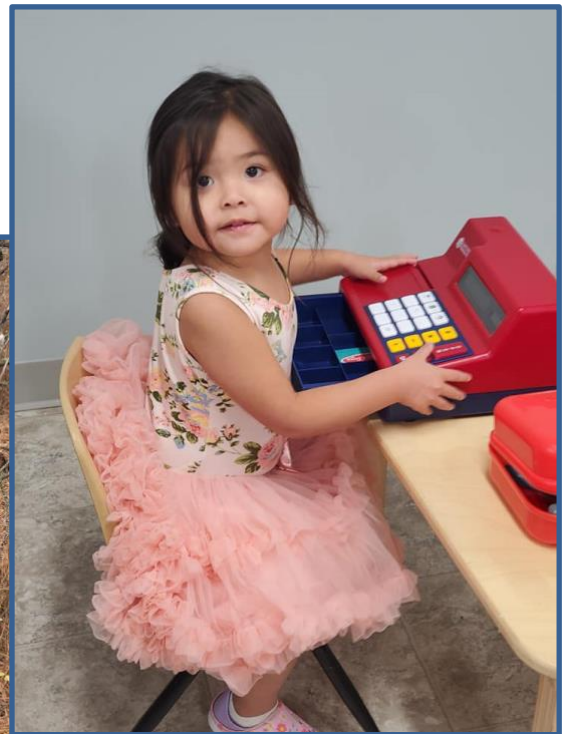
2022 Summer Immersion Symposium
