



Position: Evening Food Service Worker/Custodian

Wage: \$21/hr

Reports to: Center Director

Average hours per week: 10

Summary of Functions

The *Evening Food Service Worker/Custodian* 1) prepares and serves dinners for parents, children, and community members; 2) cleans kitchen equipment and facilities; 3) washes, sanitizes, dries and puts away dishes, and; 4) does light cleaning of school facilities as needed.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Preparation and serving of food using safe food handling practices;
- Kitchen and cafeteria cleaning including: loading, running, and unloading dish washers, washing & drying dishes, emptying and cleaning of trash, recyclables, and compost containers, cleaning food preparation and other surfaces, cleaning refrigerators and other equipment, sweeping & mopping;
- Facilities cleaning including washing windows, sweeping floors and outside walkways, washing and sanitizing doors, counter tops, walls, and other high traffic areas;
- Commitment to fulfilling the non-profit, grass-roots mission of Salish School of Spokane through a holistic approach to service, employment, and Native community building;
- Must be able to work as a team, be self-motivated, use clear communication strategies and practices, and be responsible for following school policies and procedures.

Additional Functions and Supervisory Responsibilities

Additional duties as assigned. The position does not directly supervise other staff.

Minimum Qualifications

- At least 18 years of age. Food service experience and/or excellent personal housekeeping skills required;
- Able to pass a DCYF background check.

Certificates, Licenses, Regulations

- Negative TB Test and First Aid, CPR, HIV/AIDS-Blood Borne Pathogens training required on hire;
- Food Worker's card required on hire.

Work Environment

- Work is performed primarily in a school and childcare setting, both indoors and out.
- Requires the ability to bend, stoop, lift, carry and move items weighing up to 50 pounds.
- This position requires work to be performed from 4:30-6:30 pm, Monday through Thursday when Salish School of Spokane is in session.
